**Tailgating Rules and Regulations**  
**Sponsored by the Alumni Association**

- Tailgating will start 2 hours before game time.
- All tailgaters must leave the parking area 15 minutes before game time.
- Tailgating is prohibited during half time.
- Tailgating is permitted for no more than 1 hour after the game or 6:00pm whichever is earlier.
- Tailgating is an event for Alumni, Students over 21, Parents, Visiting Team Guests, and FSU supporters ONLY.
- Tailgating is located in Stadium lot ONLY. Maximum capacity of the lot is 244 vehicles. Once the lot is full, no one will be admitted.
- RV'S prohibited
- The drinking age in the State of Maryland is 21. Providing alcohol to minors or consumption by persons under 21 is illegal and carries serious penalties. **NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 21 WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE TAILGATING AREA unless accompanied by a parent.**
- Beer and wine are the only alcoholic beverages permitted during tailgating.
- **BEER KEGS, PARTY BALLS, FUNNELS, ETC. AND GLASS BOTTLES OF BEVERAGES CONTAINING ALCOHOL ARE PROHIBITED** in parking areas. For safety reasons, we ask that all beverages be consumed from a plastic or paper cup.
- Drinking games are not allowed.
- Respect the rights of others. Avoid the use of loud and abusive language, and behavior, which prevents others from enjoying tailgating and the game.
- Please keep the Bobcat Stadium and surrounding areas clean! Trash bins will be provided in the area and trash bags are available from tailgate personnel.
- Due to risk of injury, ball playing or frisbee throwing will not be allowed on parking surfaces.
- Tents, platforms, and stages are not permitted in the tailgate areas.
- Soliciting is not permitted on the Frostburg State University campus. The selling of any item by anyone other than university personnel is prohibited unless the university has granted prior approval.

**NO ALCOHOL IS ALLOWED IN THE STADIUM.**
